ANNUAL SERVICE

During the close season Bolton Wanderers Football Club hold their Annual Service of Remembrance and Thanksgiving, conducted by the Club Chaplain Phil Mason.

The service commences at pitch-side where a wreath is laid in remembrance of all our loved ones, no longer with us, and then continues in one of the suites. During the service the names of all those inscribed on a memorial brick or entered into the memorial book, during the past 12 months, will be read out.

Names from previous years are also remembered by scrolling them on a big screen.

Relatives and friends of those being remembered will receive a personal invitation but everyone is welcome to attend this special and moving occasion.

NAT LOFTHOUSE WALKWAY



Following on from the success of the original Walkway of Fame, The Nat Lofthouse Walkway is the new area for fans to have personalised engraved bricks placed either for themselves, as a gift, or as a way of remembering a loved one.

The Nat Lofthouse Walkway is situated on the west side of the stadium, close to the main reception and the original Walkway and surrounds the long awaited Nat Lofthouse statue which was unveiled on 24th August 2013 and has proved to be a popular addition to the Stadium.

The Nat Lofthouse Walkway also pays homage to the 1958 team, winners of the FA Cup when Nat scored two unforgettable goals to lead the team to victory and lift the cup for the fourth time. A brick has been inscribed and laid for each member of that very special winning team to honour their fantastic achievement and the part they played in the history of Bolton Wanderers Football Club.

Other great names including Jussi Jaaskelainen, Kevin Davies, Ivan Campo, Gary Speed and Youri Djorkaeff can also be seen with many more to be added in future phases.

If you would like your own lasting tribute, bricks in the Walkway can be purchased and engraved with your own name or unique message to celebrate a special moment in your life - a great gift for the passionate supporter or a way to mark your own support by having your name inscribed and included in the Walkway.

You can also include the brand new BWFC logo as part of your inscription for just £25 extra. The logo can only be engraved on a double sized brick and the message will then be limited to 3 rows of text.

Black memorial bricks can also be purchased as a way of remembering your loved one and will be situated within their own area of the Walkway.

Anyone purchasing a brick will receive a certificate once the brick has been laid or at any alternative time on request.

Orders are taken all year but the bricks will be laid in two phases each year, in March and September. To place an order, please complete the attached order form.
